Unit Aims

- Support families to understand the impact of a range of anti-social behaviour
- Support families to reduce anti-social behaviour and increase positive behaviour
- Evaluate approaches used to reduce anti-social behaviour and increase positive behaviour
- Evaluate approaches used to support families who make partial progress but continue to behave anti-socially

Be able to reflect on own practice in working with families who behave anti-socially

The learner can:

- Reflect on own practice when working with families to reduce and prevent anti-social behaviour and increase positive behaviour
- Evaluate own values, attitudes and beliefs when working with families who behave anti-socially
